# **5 Scaffolding Strategies**

# for Improving Quality of Feedback

Scenario: A child is playing with blocks and is frustrated that the tower keeps falling down.



#### Ask prompting questions

"What do you think would happen if we didn't build the tower quite so tall?"





#### Give a range of possible answers

"Do you think we need bigger blocks at the bottom or should we make two smaller towers?"





### **Make suggestions**

"Your block tower keeps falling down. Do you want to try putting all the bigger blocks at the bottom?"





## **Use a demonstration**

As the teacher, make your own block tower to demonstrate how the blocks work best.





#### **Provide physical support**

The teacher can help support the blocks at the bottom or catch the block tower so the child can stabilize it.
