

Seeking Data Collectors!

The National Institute for Early Education Research (NIEER) is collaborating with multiple funders to complete state-wide studies investigating the quality of early care and education programs in various settings. Starting February 2022, our projects will launch in New Jersey, Indiana, West Virginia, and Philadelphia, PA. We are currently recruiting classroom observers to conduct CLASS observations in Infant, Toddler, and Pre-K classrooms.

Requirements:

- This position seeks graduate students, applicants with a BA/BS, or current upper-class undergraduate students focusing on child development, early childhood, psychology, or related field, with an excellent academic record (GPA of 3.0 or better).
- Experience in classroom settings and/or working with children is **highly preferred**. Knowledge about developmentally appropriate early childhood teaching practices, i.e., retired teachers or part-time teachers are encouraged to apply.
- Availability - must be able to work a **minimum of 3 days per week** from February - June during regular school hours (approximately 7:00 AM-12:00 PM).
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) Data Collectors are also needed.
Current CLASS certified individuals are encouraged to apply but this is not a requirement.
- MANDATORY training – TBD (virtual setting)

All Data Collectors must have reliable transportation; a valid driver's license; must complete a background check and research compliance certifications; and will be required to follow all project and state health regulations regarding COVID-19, which includes full vaccination.
